 Λ By-Law of the Town of Vulcan for the purpose of fixing a fee for issuing a Statement of Assessment of Parcels appearing on the assessment roll.

<u>WHEREAS</u> the Council of the Town of Vulcan deem it advisable, equitable and practical to set a schedule of fees for issuing a statement of assessment of parcels appearing on the assessment roll,

 $\underline{\text{AND}}$ WHEREAS the Municipal Taxation Act (Part 3), Section 109, being Chapter M.31 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1989, authorizes such fee,

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VULCAN IN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

 $\overline{\text{THAT}}$ the Municipal Administrator upon request therefore in writing, including a legal or other description of the parcel by which it can be located,

- 1. shall issue a written statement showing:
 - a) the description of a parcel as set out in the assessment roll, and
 - b) the latest assessed value of the land and of the improvements thereon as set out in the assessment roll

Fee \$5.00

shall issue a written statement showing a statement year by year, as set out in the assessment roll, for the years requested.

Fee \$5.00

 An elector is not liable to the payment of any fee under this bylaw for an inspection of the assessment roll as provided under

Section 42 of the Municipal Taxation Act (Part 1), Chapter M.31 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1989.

4. This By-Law shall come into effect upon the date of the final passing thereof.
