BYLAW NO. 1325-05

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF VULCAN, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROHIBITING THE USE AND CARRYING OF CELLULAR PHONE IN DIFFERENT PUBLIC FACILITIES..

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Vulcan wishes to protect the public from misuse of picture taking with cellular phones equipped with camera or other reproduction devices;

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Vulcan has determined it is in the best interests of the Town to pass a bylaw to that effect;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Vulcan, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- THAT, this bylaw shall be cited as the "Bylaw to prohibit the use or carrying of a cellular phone in different public facilities"
- 2. THAT, No Person shall use or carry a cellular phone in the Restrooms, Washrooms, Changing Rooms or other similar locations in Public Pools, Arenas, Parks and any other public facilities.
- 3. THAT, A person contravening a provision of this Bylaw and any other person liable or responsible for such contravention shall upon Summary Conviction before a Court of competent jurisdiction be liable to a fine not exceeding Twenty Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) exclusive of cost, or, in event of non-payment of the fine and cost, to imprisonment for a period not exceeding Sixty (60) days unless such fine and costs including the cost of committal are sooner paid.
- THAT, this bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the date of final reading hereof

READ for a SECOND time this 28th day of February A.D., 2005.

READ for a THIRD time this 28th day of February A.D., 2005.
