TOWN OF VULCAN

BYLAW NO. 1493-20

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF VULCAN, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE TOWN'S CHIEF ELECTED OFFICAL FROM AMONG THE ELECTED COUNCILLORS

WHEREAS, Section 150 (1) of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, provides that a council of a municipality may, by bylaw, appoint the Chief Elected Official from among the councillors, and

WHEREAS the current Council of the Town of Vulcan wishes to require future Councils to appoint the Chief Elected Official from among the Councillors,

THEREFORE, Council of the Town of Vulcan duly assembled and pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26 Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 enacts as follows:

- 1. That the Chief Elected Official be hereinafter known as and referred to as "Mayor",
- 2. That Council be required to appoint the Mayor from among the Councillors at the Inaugural Organizational Meeting following a general municipal election, and at each Annual Organizational Meeting held thereafter.
- 3. That the term of office for the appointed Mayor shall be for a period on one (1) year and shall commence on the date of initial appointment at the Annual Organizational Meeting and shall run until the date of the following Annual Organizational Meeting.
- 4. Should the office of Mayor become vacant at any point in time during the above noted term of office, Council must, at the next Council meeting, appoint a new Mayor, as outlined in Section 164 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26.
- 5. This Bylaw comes into effect upon third and final reading thereof.

READ a third time, and finally passed this 14th day of December, 2020
