

11.4 Heaven Can Wait Funding Request

At the December 12, 2016 Regular Council Meeting, Heaven Can Wait attended the meeting as a delegation and gave a presentation describing the shelter's mandate and how they could assist the Town with the homeless cat population. Heaven Can Wait committed \$10,000.00 to help initiate this program.

Heaven Can Wait requested that the Town of Vulcan consider funding this initiative in the amount of \$4,000.00 so that this program may continue. The CPO has been the point of contact for this initiative from the start and has supplied a letter for Council providing his position on this matter.
