#### **BY-LAW NO. 1231**

### OF THE TOWN OF VULCAN

#### IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL AND PORTIONS OF PUBLIC STREETS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M26.1, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 1994, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS application has been made to Council to have the streets closed, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Vulcan deems it expedient to provide for a by-law for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter creating title to and disposing of same, and

WHEREAS notice of intention of Council to pass a by-law has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and

WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the by-law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Town of Vulcan, in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and creating title to and disposing of the following described streets, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:
