Why should I clear my sidewalk?

Safety - Prevent Slips and Falls: Removing snow and ice reduces the risk of accidents for pedestrians, including children, seniors, and mail carriers.
 Emergency Access: Clear pathways ensure that emergency personnel can access homes if needed.

Civic Responsibility - Being a Good Neighbor: Shoveling helps maintain accessibility for everyone in your community, especially those with mobility challenges.

Legal Obligations - The Town has a bylaw requiring homeowners to clear snow and ice within a certain timeframe. Failure to comply may result in fines.

Prevent Property Damage - Accumulated snow can lead to water pooling and ice buildup near your property, which could cause long-term damage to driveways, walkways, or your home's foundation.

Environmental Impact - Clearing snow promptly helps prevent compaction into ice, which can reduce the need for chemical deicers that may harm plants and pollute waterways.

Exercise - Shoveling snow is a great way to stay active during the winter months, just be sure to do it safely to avoid strain. If you're unable to shovel due to physical limitations, consider hiring someone or asking a neighbor for help. Some communities even have volunteer programs to assist residents who need it.

Garbage Transfer Fee - These dollars go towards the operation of the transfer station i.e. processing of waste. The transfer station is operated by the Vulcan County Waste Commission, who in turn bills the Town on a annual basis based on a per capita fee.

Garbage Collection Fee - These dollars go towards the physical collection of waste. The Town is billed for this service by the Vulcan County Waste Commission, based on average amount of pickups during the year.

Per Cubic Meter water consumption rate - is based on charges to the Town by the Twin Valley Regional Water Commission.

Note: Your utility bill covers December 2025 and January 2026, with the rate adjustment reflected in the January 2026 portion.

- All dogs 6 months and older require a Licence
- Zero tolerance for unlicensed dogs—\$100 penalty
- Annual Dog Licence fee \$31.00 altered \$44.00 intact

- Snow and ice must be removed from sidewalks no later than 24 hours after a snow fall.
- Snow and Ice removed from private property cannot be placed on the road or boulevard
