STATEMENT:

The Town of Vulcan requires a policy to serve as a guideline for the use of the Vulcan Municipal Campground.

1. Policy

- 1.1 The park shall be open to the public year round. Access to the public washrooms and dump-station are from May 1 to September 30 weather permitting.
- 1.2 Revenue generated from the park shall go to park operations and maintenance.
- 1.3 Pre-bookings will not be accepted.
- 1.4. Maximum length of stay without a fee is **Three (3)** consecutive nights in a six month period.
- 1.5 The fee for the **Fourth** and any subsequent nights will be established in the current Rates and Fees Bylaw, per unit and:
 - (a) shall not exceed Fourteen (14) consecutive days.
 - (b) shall only be permitted from May 1 to September 30
- 1.6 All vehicles must register at the self-registration booth.
- 1.7 To utilize a stall:
 - (a) must be a recreational camping unit; (camper, trailer, motorhome, or tent)
 - (b) one camper vehicle per campsite; one camping unit and tow vehicle per campsite.
Tow vehicle must not be over one ton.
- 1.8 All pets must be on a leash. Pets must be cleaned up after.
- 1.9 Motorbikes and ATV's may not be used in the campground.
- 1.10 No business shall be conducted in the park.

- 1.11 No campfires are permitted.
- 1.12 Waste water or basin water must be disposed of where receptacles or sewer drains are provided. Pouring waste water on open ground or in sump holes dug below trailers is prohibited.
- 1.13 Quiet hours are observed from 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM.

No objectionable disturbance or unreasonable noise will be allowed at any time.

- 1.14 Users of the campground are personally responsible for campsite cleanliness, condition and the conduct of all guests.
- 1.15 Check-out time shall be Twelve (12) Noon.
- 1.16 Failure to self-register and include proper payment may result in a fine and eviction.
- 1.17 Non-compliance may result in a fine as established in the Rates and Fees Bylaw.
