



## **CAMPAIGN SIGNAGE INFORMATION**

Candidates may use a variety of media to promote their candidacy, within limits set by the Election Act and the Town of Vulcan Land Use Bylaw 1437-15.

Schedule 7

Section 2;2.2 (e)

- No advertising is allowed inside or outside a building used as a polling station
- Campaign signs may be displayed on private property with permission of the owner
- Campaign signs cannot emit sound or video and cannot be illuminated
- Campaign signs should not restrict sight lines for pedestrians or drivers
- Campaign signs must be self-supporting and less than 1.2 meters in height and less than 1.1 square meters
- Campaign signs cannot be up for more than 60 days and must be removed within 24 hours of polls closing

(August 25 to October 22, 2025).

- Campaign signs cannot include or display a ballot marked for any candidate.
