TOWN OF VULCAN E-BILL SERVICE AGREEMENT

Please read the following terms and conditions carefully, as they contain important information that should be known before agreeing to subscribe to the E-Send service.

- This service allows subscribers to view their Town of Vulcan invoices electronically. The electronic bill, also called e-send, has the same value as a paper invoice from the Town of Vulcan and should be treated as such by you.
- Printed copies of your e-bill can be used to pay at the Town office, bank, online, telephone banking, or by mailing a cheque.
- Invoice will be provided to the subscriber as a PDF attachment via the email address supplied.
- It is the subscriber’s responsibility to provide the correct email address and to inform the Town of Vulcan of any changes to their email address. Non-receipt is not justification for late payment and penalties will apply.
- When you agree to the Terms & Conditions of this service, **you will no longer receive paper copy invoices for the below agreed upon accounts from the Town of Vulcan.**
